He completed his intermediate musical studies in the **Advanced Conservatory of Music in San Sebastian**. After completing various courses that were taught by renowned teachers, in 1994 he obtained the Higher Diploma in Tuba Studies from the **Advanced Conservatory of Music in the Barcelona School of Music**.

To broaden his musical education, he completed various subsequent courses, including **courses on active and music teaching methods**; courses on **choral conducting** provided by the Gipuzkoa Federation of Choirs; a **specialist music course for primary education** in the Advanced Conservatory of Music of Barcelona; and he obtained a diploma in **Music Pedagogy and Didactics** (Level 1) in 1994.

In 1992, he was actively involved in the National Symposium on “music education in the society of the future”.

While completing his musical studies, **he has performed with various musical groups**: The Pasaia Band, Rentería Band, Hondarribia Band, City of Irún Band, Barcelona Symphonic Band, Basque National Orchestra, and in various chamber music groups and educational concerts. He is currently a member of the Municipal Symphonic Band of San Sebastian.

In 1995, he joined the clown group the “**Tutik Clowns**”.
